A motion was made to pursue a joint agreement with the City of Bay City and the Bay City Gas Company and the Bay City Community Development Corporation for the restoration project of Nile Valley Drive (Phase 1 Rehab) with the City using budgeted funds for the engineering of the project. The motion was made by Councilman, Bill Cornman and seconded by Councilman, Jason Childers. The motion was passed unanimously. Estimated time frame: 6-9 months on design, Possible 18 months before road opening.
