REGULAR ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION AND / OR APPROVAL**1. Discussion - review and discuss City Strategic Plan and goals**

Mayor Nelson presented a proposed new Vision and Mission Statement that is part of the Strategic Plan. Mayor Nelson explained that he did not feel the previous statements told us our goal and how to get there.

Mayor Pro Tem Folse motioned to approve the Vision and Mission Statements, Seconded by Councilman Westmoreland. Voting Yea: Mayor Nelson, Mayor Pro Tem Folse, Councilwoman Brown, Councilman Councilwoman Sitz, Councilman Westmoreland, Councilman Finlay. Motion carried.

The workshop continued reviewing the accomplishments and business plans of the areas of emphasis. Shawna Burkhart, City Manager, reviewed the completed goals and proposed new goals. There was discussion regarding infrastructure and the phases of Nile Valley Road and adding back downtown parking.

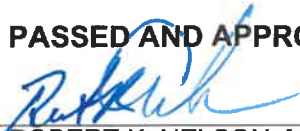
Councilman Westmoreland wanted to add to the Infrastructure goals. He requested to add personnel to Utilities and Streets and Bridges and to add equipment for drainage projects, add commercial development to Community and Economic Development. Councilman Westmoreland also stated that the Livability and Quality of Life should include Le Tulle Park and the Sports Complex. Councilman Westmoreland also emphasized the relocation of the baseball fields by Valor Park. Councilwoman Sitz stated that she would like more focus on larger parks and not neighborhood parks.

Shawna Burkhardt updated Council on the proposed Public Safety building and issues to address.
